The Education Justice Project is an award-winning program that offers for-credit U of I courses and much more to individuals incarcerated at Danville Correctional Center, a men’s medium-security prison. We consider it a matter of urgency to expand access to quality higher education, and a matter of justice that people behind bars are included in such efforts. Each fall and spring we accept applications from serious-minded faculty, staff, graduate students, and community members who wish to teach in the program. EJP instructors donate their time and expertise.

Applications are due on March 1, 2017 for Fall 2017 and, in the case of for-credit instructors, also for Spring 2018. We seek excellent teachers who are interested in teaching courses, presenting workshops, working with ESL students, participating in our prison-based anti-violence program, facilitating mindfulness groups, and more. Applicants should have interest in becoming part of a diverse, inclusive, supportive, critical community.
