# TEACH IN PRISON

The Education Justice Project offers for-credit U of I courses and other academic programs at Danville Correctional Center, a men’s medium-security prison. We consider it a matter of urgency and justice to expand access to quality higher education to incarcerated individuals. Each fall and spring we accept applications from serious-minded faculty, staff, graduate students, and community members who wish to teach in the program. We can offer a \$3k stipend for a 3-credit course.

Applications are due on March 1, 2018 for Fall 2018 and, in the case of for-credit instructors, also for Spring 2019. We seek excellent teachers who are interested in teaching courses, presenting workshops, working with ESL students, participating in our prison-based anti-violence program, facilitating mindfulness groups, academic advising, computer lab and library support, and tutoring in writing and math. Applicants should have interest in becoming part of a diverse, inclusive, supportive, critical community.
